## **Key Scriptures**

Ephesians 4:1-6  
Joshua 5:13-15, 6:1, 7:10-12  
1 Corinthians 2:13  
John 17: 20-26

## **Key Points:**

Oneness isn't something we create or force into being. True oneness is found in Christ alone, oneness is somebody (Jesus Christ) we come into. This requires the complete letting go of self in order to walk in the fullness of Him. The world, our flesh, is at enmity against the life of the Spirit which is within us, remember the Kingdom of God is within us. The flesh can't receive from the Spirit! The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolish and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

Let us be a people who surrender to Christ and call out to Him to teach us and lead us willingly into Himself. Surely He desires Truth (Jesus) in the inner parts Wisdom (Jesus) in the inmost place (Psalm 51:6)

## **Questions:**

1. What does "living a life worthy of the calling" look like in your own life?  
(think of Eph 3:16-19)
2. Paul exhorts us to not only be humble but to be "completely humble". What might prevent you from being "completely" humble?
3. Eph 4:3-6 Speaks of oneness. How are you walking in "oneness" in this expression of His body here at the Rock?
4. What is the LORD looking to see in and from us from His prayer in John 17:20-26 that we will be one? (remember oneness requires other people to be involved)
5. Encourage those at your table to give testimony to this oneness in your life.
