Key scriptures

Main Points

1. Jesus is building His Church, and He is building it through us.
2. God is the ultimate creator, architect and builder. He has the strategy for rebuilding us and building the Church all sorted out. Strategising for the building of the Church is not our role.
3. The Church God is building is established on His revelation, not our reason and ideas.
4. God’s Church is Christ centred and founded on apostolic and prophetic ministry.
5. Our role is to listen, and to obey - to follow His instructions.
6. Learning to hear and understand God’s word is a fruit of maturing in discipleship.
7. Discipleship is relational (knowing Him) and transformational (renewing of mind, sanctified by His Spirit).
8. The scriptures and our engagement with God’s Spirit reveal His character, His values and His pattern for building us and His Church.
9. Our transformation has been prophesied, biblically and in the contemporary ministry of His Spirit.
10. We must humble ourselves to the ongoing work of His Spirit in us (personally) and among us (corporately).
