### **Scriptures & Main points**

- In the last days God will anoint His people to prophesy [Acts 2:1-18 / Joel 2:28-29]
- Prophecy is a gift from God to the Church [1 Corinthians 12:7-10]
- Prophecy is an important gift for the function of the Church [1 Corinthians 12:27-28]
- Prophecy is a foundational gift for the Church [Ephesians 2:19-22]
- Prophecy is an equipping gift for the Church [Ephesians 4:11-13]
- Prophecy is a revelatory gift for the Church [2 Peter 1:19-21]
- Prophecy is a gift distributed by God in different measures of authority [Romans 12:5-7]
- Blessing comes from hearing and taking to heart God's prophetic word [Revelation 1:3]
- A hard heart prevents us from receiving and understanding God's prophetic word [Mark 8:17, Acts 28:25-27, Ephesians 4:18]
- Spiritual understanding begins in the heart [Proverbs 2:2, Proverbs 3:5]
- A soft heart is a humble heart. A humble heart is open to receiving God's prophetic word.
- God has called us to submit ourselves to each other [Ephesians 5:21]
- A humble heart enables us to submit to each other and receive from the gifts that God has anointed us with.
- Humbly honouring a prophet as a prophet brings a prophet's reward (revelation) [Matthew 10:41]
