Key scriptures

Ephesians 5
Genesis 2:15-24
Luke 2:48-52
John 14:15, 21, 23
Philippians 2:1-8
Galatians 3:26-29, Matthew 7:1-5

Main Points

1. True submission is grounded in love, trust, and respect.
2. Christ modelled both perfect submission, and perfect leadership.
3. We are all called to mutual submission to each other in the Church.
4. Our focus needs to be on how we can submit, love, and serve; not what others should be doing.

4. What can we learn from how Christ leads the church for how we lead in the church and in our homes?
