Main Points

1. Knowledge is no substitute for true spiritual growth and maturity.
2. Knowledge that is not revealed by the Spirit and steeped in love is not beneficial.
3. The Holy Spirit has been given to us to reveal truth and lead our discipleship.
4. Jesus did not teach His disciples everything He had for them, but left much to the Holy Spirit.
5. Our elders seek the Holy Spirit to lead our teaching direction.
6. We need to allow the Holy Spirit to lead our discipleship, and reveal His mysteries as and when He determines, not as our interest dictates.

3. How can we know how mature we really are?
4. Are we living in the love, unity, and mutual submission that God has led us to focus on?
5. How does the Holy Spirit lead us into all truth?
