## **Key Points**

- The power of God propels us to become His witnesses
- People who don't know the Lord are to see the Lord by the witness of our lives and God's power is an essential and non negotiable element of this process.
- The word power = "dunamis": inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth

2. Jesus while on the earth was reliant on God's power to be the witness His Father called Him to be, just as we need to be. What does this mean for us, as we are called to be "witnesses"?
