Todd White Testimony

The Gospel: “not about what’s wrong but what’s been made right”

“The cross isn’t the revelation of my sin but the revealing of my value”

God’s Love: can’t earn it, we submit to it so that we become it. We live now in two laws. Matt 22:37-39

The lamp of the body: Matt 6:22

Todd referred to this in reference to what he saw in the Christian he met and in himself after encountering Father’s love.

Righteousness: Matt 6:33, Rom 14:17

Pursuit of God in His word to be trained in what it means to be right with Him: the reality of righteousness through a relationship with the Holy Spirit.

Normal Life in Christ: Reality of no condemnation, hurt, shame or offense in Christ and the believer. Understanding people do what they do because they don’t know who they are. (Jesus’ response, Father forgive them...) We also get hurt because we don’t know who we are. Reality of being a blazing light (not a little light), destroying hell every day of our life.

Jesus is the Rest of God: Matt 11:27-30.

Living in soul rest through abiding in and learning from Jesus: The Word living and active in us.
