

# HEBREWS

Hebrews 11:8-10

## Verse 8

Q: Do we have a faith that obeys God when He calls?

Q: How comfortable are we at following when we don't know where we are going?

God CALLED Abraham to leave a KNOWN PLACE and come into an UNKNOWN PLACE and it was his FAITH (full conviction) that empowered his OBEDIENCE.

God has been calling and is calling us to leave our current knowledge and understanding of God and come into a GREATER REVEALED knowledge and understanding of Him, so that we would be able to LIVE FROM this NEW PLACE in Him. This FULL place.

**"By going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance"**

## Verse 9

**"By FAITH he lived as an ALIEN in the LAND OF PROMISE"**

Q: Why did Abraham live as an alien in the promised land?

Q: Why isn't he living as a citizen of the promised land?

**A: Because Abraham knew the promised land was only his temporary abode.**

Q: Are we citizens of the earth (earthlings) or are we citizens of the kingdom of God?

Q: Are our lives anchored to the earth, the world, the flesh or are our lives anchored to the Kingdom of God - the Spirit?

Q: What realm are OUR LIVES ANCHORED TO?

**Story about "Height safety and anchor points"  
"This earth is passing away"**

**"DWELLING IN TENTS" - TENT IS PORTABLE - NOT FIXED LIKE A HOUSE  
"FELLOW HEIRS OF THE SAME PROMISE"**

# HEBREWS

Q: Aren't we heirs of the promise of Abraham?

## Verse 10

Q: Are we looking for the city that is seen in the unseen realm?

**Hebrews 11:7 says by faith Noah, being warned by God about things not yet seen, (what things) in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household.**

**Mark 8:22-25 (man born blind)**

**Revelation 3:18 (eye salve)**

Q: What is this city whose architect and builder is God?

**Revelation 21:9-11**

**Revelation 3:12-13**

Abraham Isaac and Jacob were living for and preparing their lives in the physical for the ultimate Eternal Reward - The bride of Christ and we are to be doing Exactly the same for we are called for the SAME PROMISE!
