1 John 4:1 – 3

"Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world." ... (verse 5) They are from the world; therefore they speak as from the world, and the world listens to them.

1 John 2:15 – 16

"Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world – the lusts of the flesh, the lusts of the eyes, and the pride of life – is not of the Father, but is of the world."
