


Rock Kids covers the full range of our kids ministry from 10 months old up to Year 8 (approx 12 years old). We have 4 main groups that cover the span of pre-school to high school.

- **Creche 10 mths - 2 yrs**
- **Little Rock 3-4 yrs**
- **Rock Kids Year 1-6**
- **JC Rock Year 7-8**

Rock Kids creates discipleship environments for kids of every age, partnering with parents to ensure our kids are being brought up knowing what it means to be a follower of Christ and how that is lived out in our day to day lives.

Through interactive videos, games, crafts and stories our Rock Kids Leaders teach our children about our Father, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. Teaching them how to

engage with God and how they can apply the scriptures to their lives.

They will learn about the importance of being discipled and how to disciple one another and reach out to those around them to love and support others just as they have been loved and supported.

From Creche to JC Rock our leaders use age appropriate lessons and activities to impart the gospel to our kids and give them the opportunity to receive it.

We pray that as we partner with you the parent we will see these children trained and equipped to have a life long passion for God and His ways.

The purpose of Creche is to release parents to engage with our morning gatherings and to teach our children basic truths from the bible. Through interactive videos, songs and stories your toddler is hearing the gospel and learning that Jesus loves them and is with them always.

Our Creche is divided into two rooms, one is full of toys and activities, while the other room has a large mat area perfect for watching an interactive bible story, singing songs and eating snacks together.

Creche has a different theme each month. The bible story, song and activities are all designed to reinforce this theme and allow our little ones to take in the bottom line. Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Where's my (brown) haired, (black) eyed cutie?" Pretend to look for (him, her) and say, "There (he, she) is!" Pick your child up, hug them, and say, "I love how God made you!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for making (name of child). (He, she) is SO special. I love how You made (his, her) (name all your kinds of things about your child). I pray every time (he, she) looks in the mirror, they will see someone who is important because You made them and love them. In Jesus' name, amen."



Drive Time

As you drive, play a game where you call out a body part and your child points to it. Say, "God made your eyes!" Then your child points to their eyes. Say, "God made your hair!" Then your child points to their hair. Continue as long as your child is having fun. End by saying, "God made you, and that means you are VERY important - like super duper special to Him."



Bath Time

Teach your child how to wash their hair during bath time. When it gets soapy, show them how to make shapes with their hair. (stick up straight, big ball on top, horns like a cow, etc.) Talk about how God made their hair (color, curly, straight, thick, etc.), and that makes their hair special. Say, "Everything about you is SO important to God, He even knows exactly how many hairs are on your head!"

Little Rock cares for our pre-schoolers (3-4 year olds). These children are full of energy which makes Little Rock a high energy environment. Our children are kept engaged with lots of fun activities, an interactive bible story and some music.

To further reinforce the lesson for the day our leaders guide children through a few different activities and crafts related to that morning's story. All this and there's still time to come together for a snack to prevent those tummies from rumbling as they move into a new activity.

Little Rock follows the same theme each month as Creche but with age appropriate crafts and a bit more interaction and discussion between the children and the leaders. Each week they build upon the theme with another bible story and activities related to this story. We use First Look curriculum for the bible story, song and activities for both Creche and Little Rock.

Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "God made the sun and sky so blue. God made me, and God made you!" Tickle your child when you say, "you."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for loving us SO much that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Drive Time

As you drive, challenge your child to try and count the number of hairs on their head. When they give up or give you a random number, say, "Guess what! God knows exactly how many hairs are on your head! One, God knows everything. And two, you are SO important to God that He even thinks about how many hairs are on your head. I think that is pretty amazing!"



Bath Time

Add toy plates, utensils, and food to bathtime so your child can pretend to cook breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Talk about how we can talk to God during breakfast time, lunch time, and dinner time. We can even talk to God during playtime, bedtime, and bath time! We can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything!
